## Have you been tested for Chlamydia?

Free & confidential for under 25s

- Chlamydia is the most common sexually transmitted infection
- It affects men and women
- You may not have any symptoms
- Untreated it may lead to infertility
- You can get Chlamydia by having sex with someone who has it
- Testing for Chlamydia is a simple urine sample or self-taken vaginal swab
- Can be treated with antibiotics which are safe during pregnancy
- To avoid re-infection partners can also be treated

## Chlamydia can

- cause pelvic inflammatory disease which can lead to early miscarriage or premature birth
- be passed from mother to baby which can cause:
  - pneumonia
  - eye infection (conjunctivitis) which can be treated by taking antibiotics.
