

CHLAMYDIA**...have YOU got it?**

Top Ten Tips to 'Bag' a Chlamydia Test

1. Display posters and leaflets throughout the surgery.
2. Ensure there is a supply of kits within all consulting rooms.
3. Use our 'script' to offer a Chlamydia test.
4. Ask all 15 to 24 year olds if they have done a Chlamydia test recently.
5. Ask all 15 to 24 year olds if they have done a Chlamydia test since their last new sexual partner.
6. Patients must be 24 years of age or under, reassure them that the service is confidential.
7. Assist patient in completing the form for the test during the consultation.
8. Label the pot or the swab with the patient's first name, surname and date of birth before they do the sample.
9. Ensure patient provides the sample whilst still in the surgery and does not take the pack home.
10. If the patient declines a screen, for any reason, provide information for them to take away.
